## Rules

The following Rules apply to 'A Night with the Ghosts of Christmas'. Anyone who enters will be deemed to have understood these rules and will be bound by them.

To enter you must:

- Places will be confirmed by telephone or email by no later than 6pm on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> December 2009

- There are a maximum of 12 places. Any unsuccessful applicants will be placed on a reserve list should any drop out.
- Those unable to meet the £250 fundraising requirements may forfeit their place. All fundraising monies are non-refundable to the participants.
- Fundraising monies are to be submitted by cheque made payable to The Birmingham Repertory Theatre and sent to Ros Adams, Development Officer, Birmingham Repertory Theatre, Centenary Square, Birmingham, B1 2EP by midday on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> January 2010.
- Participants must be over 18 and provide Photographic ID
- Participants must be available from 6.30pm on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> January until 10am on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2010.
- No alcohol is to be brought onto the stage or consumed during the Night With The Ghosts experience
- A snack and drinks before bedtime and breakfast at approximately 8am will be provided
- Detailed timings and information will be sent to all participants by Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2010
- Participants must be medically fit to participate and certain medical restrictions may apply. A medical declaration form will be required to be completed prior to taking part.
- Participants will be expected to bring appropriate bedding and suitable clothing for a night on a cold stage.
- By signing these terms and conditions all participants agree that any audio recording, photograph or video taken during the event can be used by Birmingham Repertory Theatre for promotional activity.
