Thinking of leaving a gift to **The REP** in your will?

Here are some things to consider...

Nominate an executor or two. Executors ensure the instructions in your will are carried out and should always be someone you can trust such as family or friends.

Take into consideration all the things you have to leave such as savings, property and possessions. Then think about who you want to leave something to. It may help to make a list of family, friends and nominated charities before creating your will.

Consider what type of gift you wish to leave to your nominated charities, such as The REP. You can leave a **pecuniary gift** which is a specific amount of money or a **residuary gift** which is either a percentage or the remaining amount once all other gifts and expenses have been arranged.

Leaving a legacy to The REP is a very special way to support our work. It helps ensure your passion for theatre is passed on to future generations. You are not obliged to tell us if you decide to leave a gift in your will. However we would be delighted if you choose to let us know so we can keep you informed, particularly about how your gift will help shape future theatre, and so you can let us know how you would like the REP to acknowledge your gift, or if you would like it to be anonymous.
